Mulches – *Keep plants moist & weeds down.*

Besides the fact that mulch acts as a weed barrier, it also helps plants retain up to 25% more moisture than plants that don't have mulch around them. Did you know that the type of mulch you choose can actually affect the plant material around it? Precision always recommends organic vibrant mulches over cheaper dyed mulches for this exact reason. Although we will install whatever mulch you desire, organic mulches such as western red cedar and cypress helps prevent insect infestations and promote soil micro-organism activity, which in turn, improves soil quality and helps lessen soil compaction.

Should you choose to go with dyed mulch over organic mulch you should consider several things. The fact that the dyed mulches are cheaper upfront doesn't mean they are long term. This is because they lose their color much quicker than organic mulches. For example, a dyed mulch will typically lose its color in one to two years while an organic mulch can be flipped after that time frame and look as good as new for another year or two. However, you do have options to keep the color of your dyed mulch. Precision's team can come out and re-dye your mulch to eliminate the white that begins to show after a year or two as the mulch loses color.

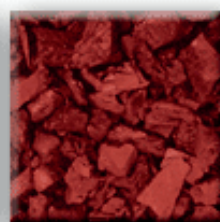

Landscape Rock

Using rock in your landscape design has many benefits. Unlike mulch, with rock we use a weed barrier that is either permeable fabric for certain situations or a plastic one, which helps water to shed away from the area with ease. This of course assumes proper grading of the sub-soil beneath the liner, which is something you won't have to worry about when you leave it to the professionals at Precision. Rock also requires much less maintenance than mulch making the slightly higher initial cost a long term cost savings in comparison because it will last ten times longer than mulch products.

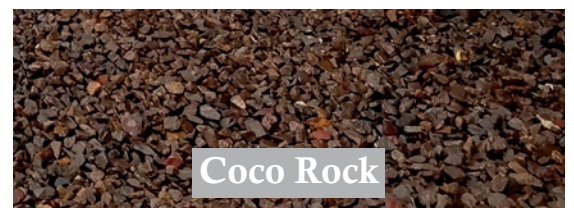

Landscape Bed Edging

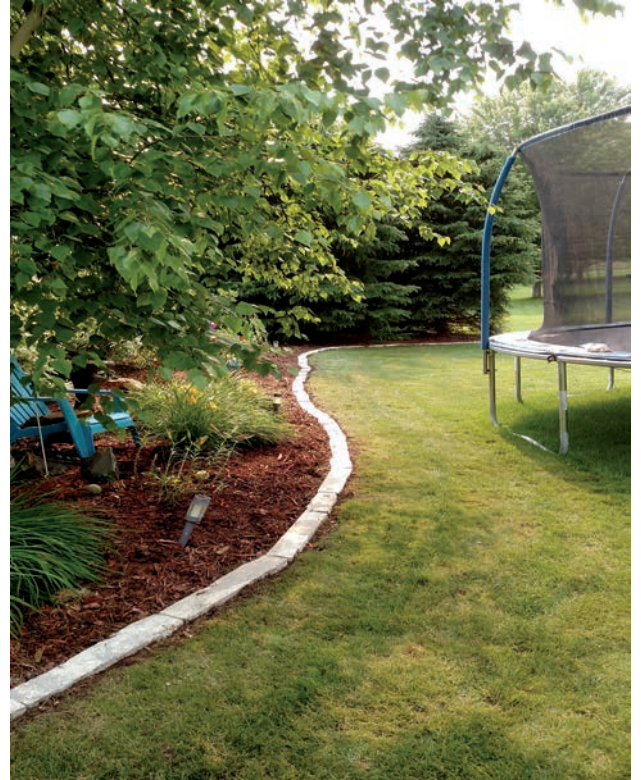
Bed edging is a key factor to consider when planning and improving your property's landscape. Edging helps separate spaces and keep pesky grass from creeping into your landscape beds while giving a crisp look and making it easier to mow. It doesn't need to be complicated. 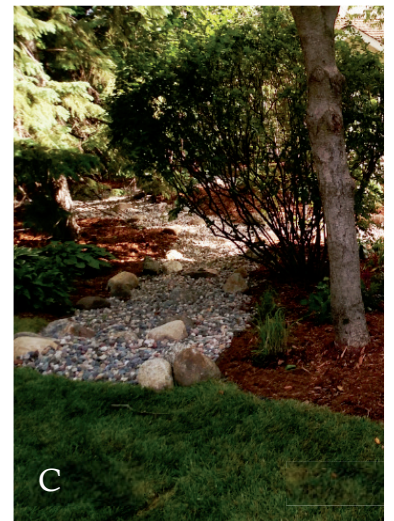

4. **Straw Blanket**- Straw blankets are used on hills and slopes because they help with erosion control to allow new grass seed to take root and take over the job of erosion control full time.



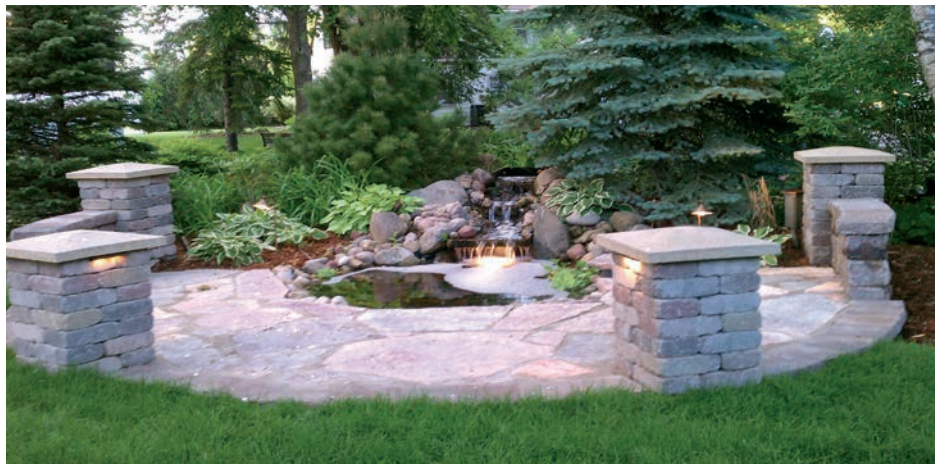
Sub-surface Drip Irrigation

Sub-surface irrigation is the most efficient way to keep the soil around your plants moist and is also the most environmentally friendly way to manage water consumption and helps minimize evaporation during the watering process. Drip irrigation not only saves water but can also reduce the amount of fertilizer that is necessary. This is possible because drip irrigation slowly releases water directly into the root zone area increasing water intake, which is one of the main objectives of fertilizer. Precision's team can set up your system to manage all of your properties plants, or just your favorite garden. We can connect these sub-surface irrigation systems into your existing irrigation system with their own zone to control the duration of the watering time, or we can install these systems as a stand alone system with a timer that simply hooks up to your garden hose. So give us a call today and make daily trips out to the garden to water a thing of the past.

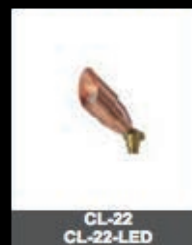

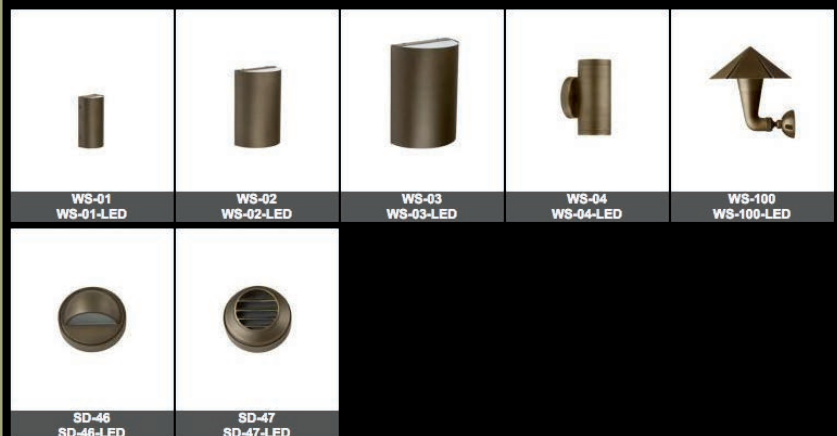

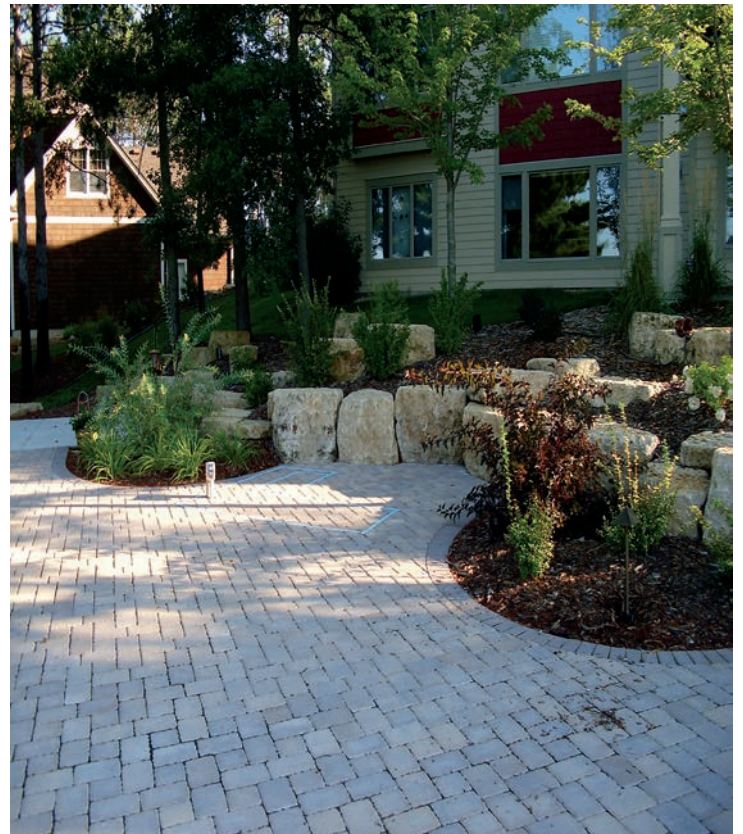
WALL SCONCES
